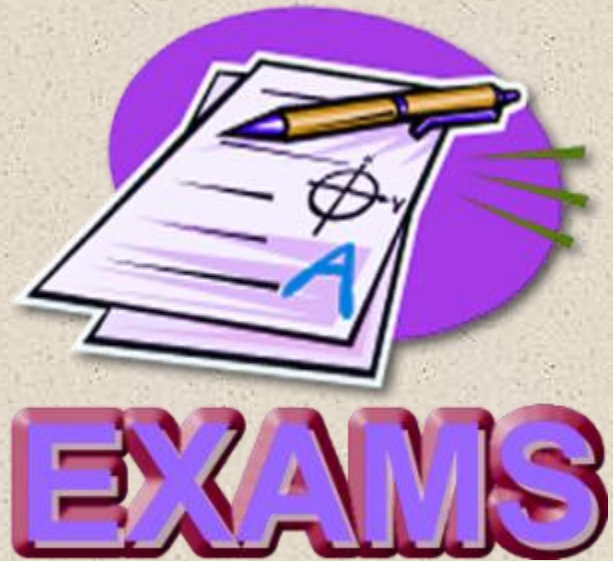
Heritage Woods Assistance Dog
