





Please provide UBC with your Personal Education Number (PEN) and order a transcript for UBC via <a href="StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca">StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca</a> by <a href="December 1">December 1</a> (if you want to be considered for a Presidential Scholars Award or early admission, or if you are applying for the UBC Centennial Scholars Entrance Award) or by <a href="January 31">January 31</a> (in all other cases). When ordering your transcript, select "send my transcript now and allow this Post-Secondary Institution to request transcript updates" and choose the default date (one year from the date of your order) so that we can receive your interim and final grades continuously.


