Please provide UBC with your Personal Education Number (PEN) and order a transcript for UBC via <u>StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca</u> by <u>December 1</u> (if you want to be considered for a Presidential Scholars Award or early admission, or if you are applying for the UBC <u>Centennial Scholars Entrance Award</u>) or by <u>January 31</u> (in all other cases). When ordering your transcript, select "send my transcript now and allow this Post-Secondary Institution to request transcript updates" and choose the default date (one year from the date of your order) so that we can receive your interim and final grades continuously.
