

Hello All,

Firstly, thank you for taking the time to fill out the surveys. This information has been helpful in planning and organizing not only classes but how best to make September 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> work.

Below is a schedule for **Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup>**. It is imperative that students come at their assigned times. We will have the tables set up on the grass field. The tables will be labelled, distant from one another and cones will be set up as indicators for line ups. This is simply a check-in for attendance purposes and where students will receive information regarding the next day, Friday, September 11<sup>th</sup>, and receive a mask. It is expected to take less than 10 minutes. **Students will be required to wear the mask once they receive it on Thursday and on Friday to attend school.**

***How do you read this table?***

- If Mr. **McCutcheon** were a Grade 6 student, he would need to come at 9:30AM and go to Table 2 on the bottom field.
- If Ms. **Nichols** were a Grade 7 student, she would need to come at 11:00AM and go to Table 1 on the bottom field.
- If Ms. **Guo** were a Grade 8 student, she would need to come at 1:00PM and go to Table 5 on the bottom field.

**Hint:** Take a highlighter, find your *grade*, then *find the table number & time* where your last name lands. Highlight that section and take note of your child's **time and table #** for Thursday's attendance!
