At Minnekhada, staff continues to prioritize and focus our professional development on learning about and enhancing our teaching with a focus on the development of students' core competencies, their ability to self-assess and the big ideas that are at the forefront of the new curriculum. At this month's staff meeting, we are exploring the **First People's principles of learning** and sharing our practices in this area as well as discussing resources and opportunities available to us.
