- Last DPAC meeting was April 26th
- Couple of reminders
- Submit gaming application by end of June Ted to action
- There was a change in gaming grants, they cannot be spent on scholarships moving forward. This will not impact us
- Superintendent's report:
 - District budget was approved, positive feedback so far from the community
 - NEW District Principal for Anti-Racism
 - Elimination of Elementary principals Teaching Time
 - No layoffs for teachers, very good news!
 - 15 permanent TTOC created
 - About 25% of parents aren't getting report cards from the myed report site, discussion is taking place to ensure all have easy access to report cards
 - "Head of Learning Services", new position for elementary schools
 - Presentation around PAC's role in securing playgrounds and play areas

New elementary school

- Opportunity for rooftop playground
- Discussion is to be had around who is responsible for funding the playground, guidelines, function, accessibility, exact timelines etc.
- Goal is to share use of the grass field/soccer field between the new elementary school and Moody middle
- Timeline for new school opening is still on target for September-December 2024
- Discussion was had around putting any surplus PAC funds into savings to put towards future playground/play space funding. Other options to be explored to raise funds for the playground:
 - Community grants
 - Corporate sponsorship
 - Other local community partners that might be willing to sponsor the play area
 - Consider parent committee to help lead this, supported by the PAC to be discussed at PAC meeting in September
- Celebration of learning dates May 10th and 11th
 - Communication will be shared by teachers
- May 19th two dance performances
 - Information on timing to be shared shortly
 - Day will be split into two sessions, parents can attend one or the other
