1. **Items from home**. Please send your children with as many of these items (rinsed out and clean) as possible:

All Students

Yogurt, margarine, sour cream containers – large and small (any size)

Applesauce type cups, small (ex. Heinz, Dole, Del Monte type)

Grade 4/5s Only

Milk jugs, 4L (empty, rinsed and air dried)



Students should bring not just for themselves, but as many items as possible to ensure enough “junk” is available for everyone to make and take home a project. There are boxes in the front foyer in front of the PAC kitchen for these rinsed out and clean items.
