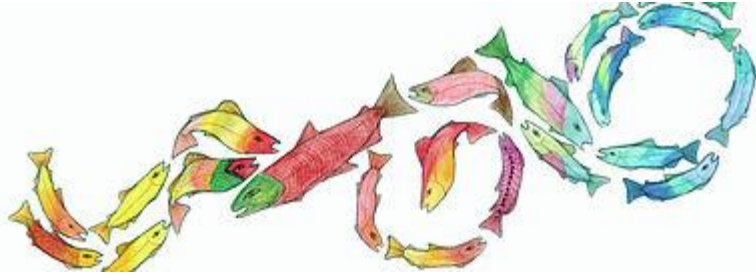




PITT RIVER COMMUNITY SCHOOL
