<u>Transition Plan</u>	Student has a well-thought out transition plan from high school to "real life" with a back-up plan. Student has answers for items such as Do I have to pay rent, school, phone bills etc., Do I need student loans?	Student <u>does not</u> have a well-thought out transition plan from high school to "real life" with a back-up plan.
<u>Evidence</u>	Student outlines and/or displays evidence of who they are, their accomplishments Example: photos, trophies, acceptance letters and/or other memorabilia	Student <u>does not</u> outline and/or provide evidence of who they are, their accomplishments
<u>Overall Presentation</u>	Student was well prepared and able to communicate their future plans. Student answers were well thought out and realistic. Student was dressed appropriately.	Student <u>was not well</u> prepared. Did not take the processes seriously. Student was dressed inappropriately.
