CHALLENGE EXAMS: The Delta School District is offering **Language Challenge Exams** for Grade 11 and 12 Language Courses. This year they will be offering Language Challenge Exams for the following courses: French 11/12, Japanese 11/12, Korean 11/12, Mandarin 11/12, Punjabi 11/12 and Spanish 11/12.

The purpose of Challenge is to permit students to obtain credit for a Grade 11 or 12 course who have already acquired the appropriate learning elsewhere. A successful challenge results in a student receiving credit for the appropriate content as well as a school mark.

To APPLY: students must access and complete the online form available here--

Once the student has typed the application online, they must print pages 7 to 10 inclusive of the application and bring to Mr. Gibney at lunch in the MPR who confirms student eligibility and approves the request. Students must also be advised that a deposit is required, only refundable if the student completes the exam. Students must also be able to travel to Delta to complete the exam on **January 23 or 24, 2021**.

The deadline for applications is FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2020 at lunch break.

ATTENTION GRADE 12s: Need a transcript? You need to complete the Ministry of Education's Post Secondary Request Form. This must be done in order to complete your university/college application process. It will also give you access to transcripts that can be used to apply for scholarships. See the following document that provides two "how to" videos for this TWO step process. The first step is to register for your BCeID and then to log in and order/view/send your transcript. All students applying to university/college must request their FINAL transcript to be shared with their post secondary institutions that you are applying to. Please email your counsellor if you have any challenges with this process. Students will need their PEN number to complete this process, which can be found on your report card.



Student Transcript Request Service

Purpose of the Post-Secondary Transcript Request Form

To help transition from secondary school to post-secondary education, your transcripts can be sent to various universities, colleges and institutes. This is a two step process, as you must have a BCeID to access the Student Transcript Service. See video tutorials below.

Your choices must be entered by end of April.

You will need your Personal Education Number (PEN) and a BCeID in order to create an account and access the Student Transcript Request form. Once you have signed in with your BCeID, you will have access to the menus to select which post-secondary institutions you want to receive your transcript. This is an important part of ensuring you provide the final transcript to the institutions. If not completed, you may risk your admissions to post-secondary opportunities.
