2021 PSAT TEST - WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 13th: If you're thinking of college in the U.S. you will likely need either a SAT or ACT score for admission consideration. PMSS offers the Practice SAT to Port Moody students; an inexpensive way to prepare for the SAT. Registration fee is \$30, payable by cash or by cheque made out to Port Moody Secondary School. The test will start at 8:30 am and takes approximately 3.5 hours. Registration begins *Friday, October 1*st. Mr. Gibney will be available lunch times in the MPR to collect your fee and register you for the exam; first come, first registered – registration with full fee payment closes *FRIDAY, OCTOBER 8*th.
