NEED TO WRITE A PROVINCIAL ASSESSMENT?

Which assessments need to be completed? For this year, all students must complete a Numeracy 10 and Literacy 10 assessment. This does not need to be completed in Grade 10 but must be completed prior to graduation. A Literacy 12 assessment is expected to be introduced next school year.

If you are in Grade 12: We know who you are and will be scheduling you to write in April. We will confirm this with you prior to Spring Break.


If you are in Grade 11: Please complete this [form](#) by **Monday, February 15th**. We will then contact you once we have confirmed a time for you to complete your assessment(s). Please note that we will do our best to schedule you this year but cannot confirm a spot until we know our numbers. Current Grade 12 students will be given priority for sittings this year.

If you are in Grade 10: Please complete this [form](#) by **Monday, February 15th**. We will then contact you once we have confirmed a time for you to complete your assessment(s). ***If you are in a Quarter 2, 3, or 4 English and/or Math class there is no need for you to complete this form as you will write in class.*** Please note that we will do our best to schedule you this year but cannot confirm a spot until we know our numbers. Current Grade 12 will be given priority for sittings this year.
