#### STUDENT POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTION (PSI) SELECTIONS - JULY 10th:

By **July 10, 2021,** Grade 12 and adult students are encouraged to visit the <u>StudentTranscripts Service</u> to authorize release of their transcript data to their chosen post-secondary institutions for admissions purposes.

#### For Students: StudentTranscripts Service (STS):

To register for STS, students must first create a Basic BCeID account. Refer to <a href="help documentation">help documentation</a> for guidance.

Students need only complete their PSI selections once in the current school year but may add to their selections at any time up to **July 10, 2021**. Current students may make up to 25 selections free of charge within six months after completing their last course. After six months, students will be charged \$10 per transcript.

#### **Distribution of Transcripts:**

How and when students' transcript information is sent will depend on the PSI and the option selected by students in the StudentTranscripts Service:

- 22 B.C. PSIs and the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) can pick up final marks and transcript updates electronically throughout the year (when authorized by the student)
- Six B.C. PSIs, University of Alberta and University of Calgary will receive final marks through a batch electronic data transfer sent by July 31 (followed by weekly updates to early September for students with record changes)
- All other PSIs will receive paper transcripts, which will be sent by July 31<sup>st</sup> (typically arriving by mail at PSIs in the first week of August, or later, depending on the location)

Students can also choose the send 'now' option to send their most current transcript to a selected PSI at any time. They should review the transcript carefully to ensure it is complete and accurate.

For a \$10 fee, transcripts can also be sent via a PDF download to any email entered by the student. Graduating students can also order one, free printed official transcript (by mail) as soon as their transcript indicates graduation.

## **Secondary Academic Completion** (formerly known as "Remedial") July 13 to 30, 8:30-11:30AM or 12:00-3:00PM Daily

Locations: Gleneagle

Courses: Grades 9 & 10 English, Math, Science & Social

These courses provide a path for students who achieved 40-49% in a course (during this 2020-2021 school year) to attain a passing grade. Students will be able to upgrade their mark to 50% (C-).

These courses will follow a hybrid format: Students will attend in-person for a Face-to-Face class once a week (either Thursday or Friday; you will be notified before the course starts as to which day you are to attend) and will attend online scheduled classes the other days.

Registration for Remedial courses is by referral only, see website or your high school counsellor for details. Referrals will be accepted until June 25. The referral form will collect some brief information from your teacher so we can customize your course to what you need to complete.

July 6 to August 11. Morning and Afternoon Courses available.

Fast Track courses this summer will follow a hybrid for-

- Two weekly synchronous (online) class sessions
- One weekly in-person Face-to-Face class session on the weeks of July 12, 19, 26 and Aug. 2: All students must attend these Face-to-Face class sessions, which will include assessments/quizzes etc. Each student will be notified, in advance of the course start-up, as to which of these in-person days they will be required to attend.
- Online work & online tutorial support

This program is best suited for students wishing to complete the selected course within a 6 week timeline.
