 - Language: the language of your choice
4. Complete the survey by clicking on the appropriate circle to answer each question. Move to the next set of questions by clicking on the right arrow in the bottom right corner of the screen. Click on the left arrow to navigate back.
5. When you finish the survey, you will get a message “Thank you for sharing your views”.
6. Once complete, your school will have the results immediately.
