Please be reminded that Ranch Park is a **nut-free** school. Some of our students have life threatening allergies to nuts. Please do not send your child with nut based products of any kind.

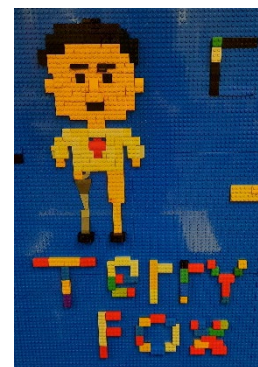
