- b) The team having the best ratio of <u>won/lost sets</u>, considering matches <u>between the tied teams</u> will be ranked higher.
- c) The team having the best ratio of <u>won/lost sets</u>, considering <u>all matches</u> of the round, will be ranked higher
- d) The team having the best ratio of <u>points for/against</u>, considering all matches played <u>between the tied teams</u>, will be ranked higher
- e) The team having the best ratio of <u>points for/against</u>, considering <u>all matches</u> played during the round will be ranked higher.
- f) As determined by the coordinator
