DISTRICT AUTHORITY SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS (28) \$1250

1. District Authority Scholarship Awards are awarded to graduating students who have **specialized** and excelled in any of the following areas:

- Indigenous Languages & Culture** (at school or in the community)
- Fine Arts** (Visual Arts, Performing Arts)
- Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies** (Business Education, Technology Education, Home Economics)
- Physical Activity** (Athletics, not limited to Physical Education courses)
- International Languages** (including Challenge and External Assessments)
- Community Service** (volunteer activity)
- Technical and Trades Training** (culinary, carpentry, mechanics etc. Train in Trades programs)

2. Criteria:

Students must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. Students will be evaluated on marks in specified courses (must demonstrate **superior** achievement), citizenship and work habits. Additional criteria apply:

- Indigenous Languages & Culture:** Extensive involvement at school or in the community in Indigenous studies/culture.
- Fine Arts (Visual and Performing):** Marks in a minimum of 3 visual arts courses at the grade 11 and 12 level, marks in a minimum of 3 courses in performing arts at the grade 11 and 12 level and a major school performance in grade 12.
- Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies:** Marks in a minimum of 4 courses at the grade 11 and 12 level (2 at the grade 12 level) focussing in one area, for example business education, or technology education etc.
- Physical Activity:** Strong athlete involved in school athletics and/or athlete in community.
- International Languages:** Second Language at the Grade 12 level.
- Community Service:** Extensive involvement in volunteer service both in school and in the community.
- Technical and Trades Training:** Marks in a minimum of 4 courses at the grade 11 and 12 level (2 at the grade 12 level) focussing in one area, culinary, mechanics, carpentry **or** participation in a district Train in Trades program.
