WELCOME TO SCOTT CREEK MIDDLE

How will our first day look?

On Tuesday, September 4th community placement lists will be displayed at the front entrance of Scott Creek Middle School. All students will be assigned to one of six communities: Grizzlies, Penguins, Wolves, Foxes, GOATS or Panthers. Students will be listed alphabetically on Community lists.

Students will be placed in classes within the community during the first week of school. Our goal is to develop balanced, educationally sound classes. **Much time and discussion is involved in the placement of each student and several factors are considered including gender balance, academics, learning needs, and social and emotional development.** With all these factors considered, every effort is made to ensure that the best possible educational placement is made for all students. Important information provided by the grade 5 teachers in our feeder schools and your input collected on the parent articulation form helped us to place our new grade 6 students. We have also spent a great deal of time reviewing the placement of our current students into classes for the next year.

PARKING: We strongly encourage students to walk to school on Tuesday and every day. If you plan to come with your student on Tuesday, please park on a side street or at Eagleridge Pool and walk with your student. Parking at our school is very limited – DO NOT PARK IN THE DRIVE THRU LANES. If you plan to use the drive thru – please adhere to drop off procedures to ensure that our students are safe. DRIVE SLOWLY – PULL AS FAR AHEAD AS POSSIBLE TO KEEP TRAFFIC MOVING – WATCH OUT FOR STUDENTS IN DESIGNATED CROSSWALKS – PLEASE FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY STAFF IN THE DRIVE THRU.

As the students arrive at Scott Creek Middle, staff will be outside to greet students, ensure they know their community and to direct them to their community meeting area.

Please let your student know if they are confused or lost, simply ask an adult and they will help you.

At the end of Tuesday's attendance and brief meeting, teachers will tell their community where to meet and what supplies to bring on Wednesday, September 5th. School will start on Wednesday at 8:35 am for all students and will go until 3:00 pm. A variety of community activities are planned for the first week of school. <u>Students are reminded to bring a recess snack and lunch on Wednesday as it is a full day</u>.
