# Welcome to Scott Creek Middle School

How Your First Day at Scott Creek Middle School will look like on Tuesday, September 3:

## All grade 6 Students Start Time: 9:30 am End Time: 10:00 am

# All grade 7 and 8 Students Start Time: 10:30 am End Time: 11:00 am

As the students arrive at Scott Creek Middle, staff will be outside to greet students, ensure they know their community and to direct them to their community meeting area.

At the end of Tuesday's meeting, teachers will tell their community where to meet and what supplies to bring on Wednesday, September 4. School will start on Wednesday at 8:35 am for all students and will go until 3:00 pm. A variety of community activities are planned for the first week of school. Students are reminded to bring lunch on Wednesday as it is a full day.

## How will we know what class/community we are in this year?

On Tuesday, September 3rd community placement lists will be displayed at the front entrance of Scott Creek Middle School. Mandarin Bilingual students are in Penguins and Montessori students are in Foxes. Students will be listed alphabetically on these community lists.
